LifeConnect

Provides suicide prevention services as well as support for people who have been bereaved by suicide. Bereavement services provide one-on-one and group support to families, friends and colleagues who have been bereaved by suicide.

Provides practical support to people for up to three months following a suicide attempt. The service is a BeyondBlue initiative and aims to prevent further episodes of self-harm by providing a proactive and coordinated support following discharge.
